

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-11

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE HOPKINS COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO THE USE OF THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT SERVICES.

Whereas, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court, desires to amend its Administrative Code of Hopkins County as the same pertains to the employment process as found on Pages 5 and 6 of the Hopkins County Fiscal Court Personnel Administrative Policies and Procedures, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HOPKINS COUNTY THAT THE Administrative Code of Hopkins County be amended as follows:

On Page 6 under the heading of Announcement of Position, the following shall be substituted:

All employment applications shall be processed through the Kentucky Department of Employment Services (DES). This program will allow for all the citizens of the County to be made aware of possible job openings. In addition, DES will keep a formal record of all applicants making application to the County for employment.

When vacancies cannot be filled internally, each county department wanting to hire from outside sources shall submit a written or verbal order to DES stating its hiring qualifications. DES will then place the order in public view and record all transactions in regard to the job order.

Should job applicants contact any county personnel, they should be directed to DES for processing.

This Ordinance shall become effective following publication on November 1, 2003.




