

ORDINANCE 2005-2

**AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY RELATING
TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND THE AMENDMENT THEREOF.**

WHEREAS, the County of Hopkins has realized unbudgeted receipts in the General Fund from a Homeland Security Grant. Be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of the County of Hopkins, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

SECTION ONE: The budget for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 is amended to:

A. Increase the receipts of the General Fund by \$399,050 to include unbudgeted receipts from:

SECTION TWO: The amounts adjusting the receipt and expenditure accounts in Section One are for governmental purposes.





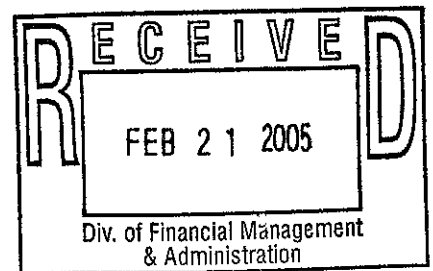

 STATE LOCAL FINANCE OFFICER


