

ORDINANCE 2007-13

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE 2007 TAX RATES FOR TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY IN HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Hopkins Fiscal Court introduction of Tangible Personal tax rates were set at 25.76 cents per One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollar assessed valuation.

Following proper notice for a public hearing and following the public hearing, and upon second reading of the Ordinance, the County tax rates for 2007 were introduced and adopted:


Tangible Personal Property tax rates were set at 25.76 cents per One Hundred (\$100.00) assessed valuation.
