

ORDINANCE 2007-5

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET
AND APPROPRIATIONS**

WHEREAS, the proposed budget was tentatively approved by the Fiscal court on the 15th day of May, 2007, and approved as to form and classification by the State/Local Finance Officer on the 21st day of May, 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County, Commonwealth of Kentucky:




