ORDINANCE NO. 07-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 99-1 OF THE COUNTY OF HOPKINS,
KENTUCKY RELATING TO IMPOSING A LICENSE FEE UPON INSURANCE
COMPANIES FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE COUNTY OF HOPKINS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF HOPKINS, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 99-1 of the County of Hopkins, Kentucky is hereby amended so as to add the following provisions:

REQUEST FOR REFUND

No insurance company shall be entitled to a refund for any tax erroneously paid pursuant to the terms of this Ordinance unless the request for refund be made to the County of Hopkins in writing within 18 months of the end of the calendar year on which said tax is paid. Additionally, said request shall be accompanied by documentation supporting said request which shall include at least the following:

- (a) the name and address of each and every insured upon whom tax was erroneously paid
- (b) the type of risk being insured against
- (c) the amount of the insurance premium charged by the company
- (d) such other information as may be reasonably requested by the County

Further, unless request for refund be made as set forth above, no set off may be made by the company for erroneously paid premiums against future taxes owed.

This ordinance shall take effect and may be enforced upon second reading and publication.

Upon motion of Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Groves, the ordinance, as first read was approved .

Whereupon the vote was called, and on roll call, the Ordinance was adopted.


