

ORDINANCE 2010-3

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET
AND APPROPRIATIONS**

WHEREAS, the proposed budget was tentatively approved by the Fiscal court on the 25th day of May, 2010, and approved as to form and classification by the State/Local Finance Officer on the 27th day of May, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County, Commonwealth of Kentucky:




